UNDERSTANDING FINANCIAL AID SCHOLARSHIP TIPS



TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- 1. Follow the directions outlined for the scholarship
 - If there is a word or page limit on your response, follow it
 - Include all supporting documents that are requested
 - Save these in one place for future use
- 2. Be specific and detailed about your past challenges and achievements
 - Be honest and be yourself
 - Don't use profane or crude language
- 3. Indicate "Not Applicable (N/A)" where appropriate
- 4. Don't leave questions blank
- 5. Complete all sections
- 6. Pay attention to deadlines
 - Understand whether the application deadline states is "postmarked by" vs. "received by"
 - Make a calendar appointment to follow up as needed
 - Don't wait until the last minute! You might need transcripts or recommendation letters
- 7. Proofread! Proofread! And then have someone else proofread.
- 8. If you're awarded, send a thank you note.
- 9. Be sure to stay within the scholarship award guidelines to be considered again.
- 10. Save a copy of the guestions and responses for future reference.
